REPATRIATION OF GREEK CHILDREN

Letter dated 21 September 1951 addressed to the President of the
General Assembly by the representative of the Union of Soviet
Socialist Republics to the United Nations

New York, 21 September 1951

The Permanent Mission of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to the United Nations has received the letter reproduced below, together with a memorandum on the question of the repatriation of Greek children, from the Greek Aid to Children Committee.

"To H.E. Mr. Yacob Malik,

"Your Excellency,

"Please find enclosed the memorandum of the Greek Aid to Children Committee on the question of the repatriation of Greek children.

"A few months ago, the International Red Cross sent out a circular containing accusations to the effect that the Red Cross Societies of the People's Democracies were not co-operating with its endeavour to repatriate Greek children.

"The Greek Aid to Children Committee (EVOP) has deemed it useful to inform public opinion on the question of the harbouring of Greek children in the People's Democracies and is submitting the present memorandum to that end.
