## Lette: lated 9 September 1991 from Permanent Representative of Guatemala +0 +he United Nations addressed +0 the Secretary-General

I have pleasure in transmitting to you herewith the **communiqué from** the Government of Guatemala containing a clear recognition of the State **of Belize** and referring to the significant progress towards reaching a **final** solution of the dispute between Guatemala and **Belize**; it **read8 88** follows:

"The Government of the Republic of Guatemala declares that the recent decision by the State of Belize to limit it8 territorial sea and it8 zone of exclusive economic exploitation makes it clear to the Government of Guatemala that the right of the Republic of Guatemala to it8 own territorial sea on the Caribbean coast and to it8 own exclusive economic zone is guaranteed.

"Similarly, the Government of Guatemala welcome8 the statement by Belize assuring Guatemala permanent acce88 to the Caribbean Sea from El Petén department and use and development of port facilities in the State of Belize, and also the right to participate in the joint exploitation of areas of Belize's zone of exclusive economic exploitation for their mutual benefit.

"In view of the foregoing, the Government of Guatemala expresses its readiness to pursue direct discussions with the independent State of Belize in order to reach a final solution to the dispute, thereby enabling us to live in peace and harmony as neighbouring countries and to move ahead with the development of our peoples,

"The Government of Quaternala considers that the momentous strides made within the framework of international law are a major contribution to the joint effort to bring peace and stability to our region.

Guatemala, 5 September 1991"
