II. Replies received from Governments: Ukraine

Replace the existing text with the following:

UKRAINE

[Original: English]

[6 October 1997]

1. The Government of Ukraine has pursued a policy of strict compliance with the purposes and principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations, in particular the principles of sovereign equality of States and non-interference in their internal affairs.

2. Ukraine has not adopted any legislation or regulations whose extraterritorial effects might affect the sovereignty of other States and the legitimate interests of entities or persons under their jurisdiction, or the freedom of trade and international navigation.

3. The Government of Ukraine does not accept the use of economic measures as a means of achieving political aims and upholds in its relations with other countries the fundamental principles of the Charter of the United Nations, the norms of international law and the freedom of trade and navigation.
