Letter dated 25 April 2016 from the Permanent Representative of the Sudan to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

With reference to paragraph 3, item 55, of the summary statement by the Secretary-General of matters of which the Security Council is seized and of the stage reached in their consideration (S/2016/10), regarding the letter dated 20 February 1958 from the Representative of the Sudan addressed to the Secretary-General (S/3963), and following our letter dated 16 March 2016 (S/2016/252), I have the honour to enclose herewith two letters from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of the Sudan, Ibrahim Ahmed Abd al-Aziz Ghandour, addressed to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Arab Republic of Egypt, Sameh Hassan Shokry Selim, and the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Adel Ahmed Al-Jubeir, respectively, regarding the agreement on the delimitation of maritime borders signed by Saudi Arabia and Egypt, and its links to the status of the Sudanese Halaib triangle (Halaib-Shalatin-Abu Ramad) and the maritime boundaries of the triangle (see annexes I and II).

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter and its annexes circulated as a document of the Security Council.
