Report of the Military Staff Committee

I. Introduction

1. The present report of the Military Staff Committee covers the period from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2022.

II. Background

2. The Military Staff Committee was established in accordance with Article 47 of the Charter of the United Nations and Security Council resolution 1 (1946). The Committee has a mandate to advise and assist the Council on all questions relating to the military requirements of the Council for the maintenance of international peace and security, the employment and command of forces placed at its disposal, the regulation of armaments, and possible disarmament.

III. Summary of the activities of the Committee

3. The Committee functioned continuously under the revised draft statute and revised draft rules of procedure contained in document S/115 of 1 August 1946, during the period under review. It has held a total of 28 meetings and discussed 39 topics.

4. Military representatives of the elected members of the Security Council actively participated in 28 meetings. Representatives of Secretariat departments were invited to brief the Committee and contributed to discussions: the Department of Peace Operations on 20 topics, the Department of Political and Peacebuilding Affairs on nine topics, the Department of Operational Support on three topics and the Department of Management Strategy, Policy and Compliance on one topic. All the Heads of Peacekeeping Military Components were also invited to brief the Committee.

5. Current United Nations peacekeeping and special political missions were the focus of 26 briefings, and various thematic issues were discussed at 13 meetings (see enclosure I).

6. From 6 March to 29 July, there was no military representative of the Russian Federation accredited to the Committee. In accordance with the revised draft rules of procedure, it is the assessment of the Committee members that the absence of a member “does not invalidate the functioning of the Committee”. The interpretation is that the Committee may not hold an extraordinary meeting unless every delegation is represented, but that regular meetings of the Committee are not subject to that rule.

7. During the reporting period, the Committee planned and was prepared to conduct two field missions. The mission to the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and the mission to both the United Nations Interim Security Force for Abyei and the United Nations Mission in South Sudan were conducted in another format owing to the absence of some members.

8. The Committee continues to announce all meetings and provisional agendas in the Journal of the United Nations and on the website (www.un.org/securitycouncil/subsidiary/msc), which is available in the six official languages of the United Nations and offers swift and easy access to the programme of work and current information on the Committee.
9. In accordance with paragraph 178 of General Assembly resolution [60/1](#) entitled “2005 World Summit Outcome”, the Committee continues considering its composition, mandate and working methods.
10. Albania remained unrepresented on the Military Staff Committee during the period under review as they did not appoint a Military Representative.
11. The Committee remained prepared to carry out the functions assigned to it under the terms of Article 47 of the Charter.
