Letter dated 8 July 2024 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2699 (2023), by which the Council authorized the deployment of a multinational security support mission to Haiti.

Set out in the annex to the present letter is a note verbale, dated 24 June 2024, from the Permanent Mission of Guatemala to the United Nations, in which the Permanent Mission refers to an offer to provide personnel to the Multinational Security Support Mission.

The Permanent Mission of Guatemala to the United Nations, with reference to Security Council resolution 2699 (2023), has the honour to register the interest of the Government of Guatemala in joining the Multinational Security Support Mission in Haiti.

In this regard, the Government of Guatemala, aware of the current situation in Haiti and based on its previous experience in the country and in accordance with the capabilities of the Guatemalan Army, is offering to deploy a military police contingent, at the company level, including personal equipment.

Furthermore, the Government of Guatemala wishes to indicate that the Regional Peace Operations Training Centre is available, with battalion-level capacity, for the training of units prior to their deployment to the mission area.

The Permanent Mission of Guatemala to the United Nations would appreciate it if this information could be submitted to the competent authorities and relevant stakeholders for consideration.
