Taking into account the comments made at the annual session, the draft country and area programme documents will be revised and posted on the UNICEF Executive Board website, at the latest, six weeks after the annual session for further review by members of the Executive Board. The revised country programme documents will be approved by the Executive Board on a no-objection basis at the 2010 second regular session unless at least five members have informed the secretariat in writing of their wish to bring a particular country programme before the Executive Board.

In accordance with Executive Board decision 2008/17, the Executive Board will be informed of the reasons for deferment of the presentation of six draft country programme documents from the annual session to the second regular session (E/ICEF/2010/CRP.10).
