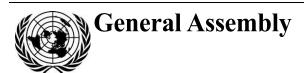

Sustainable development: disaster risk reduction

Germany, United Arab Emirates and United States of America: * revised draft decision**

Authorization for the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction regarding the hosting of the secretariat of the Santiago network for averting, minimizing and addressing loss and damage associated with the adverse effects of climate change

The General Assembly, recalling the relevant resolutions regarding the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction, including resolutions 54/219 of 22 December 1999 and 56/195 of 21 December 2001, authorizes the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction to enter into a memorandum of understanding with the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and the Conference of the Parties serving as the Meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement regarding the hosting of the secretariat of the Santiago network for averting, minimizing and addressing loss and damage associated with the adverse effects of climate change, in line with decisions 6/CMA.5 and 2/CP.28.
