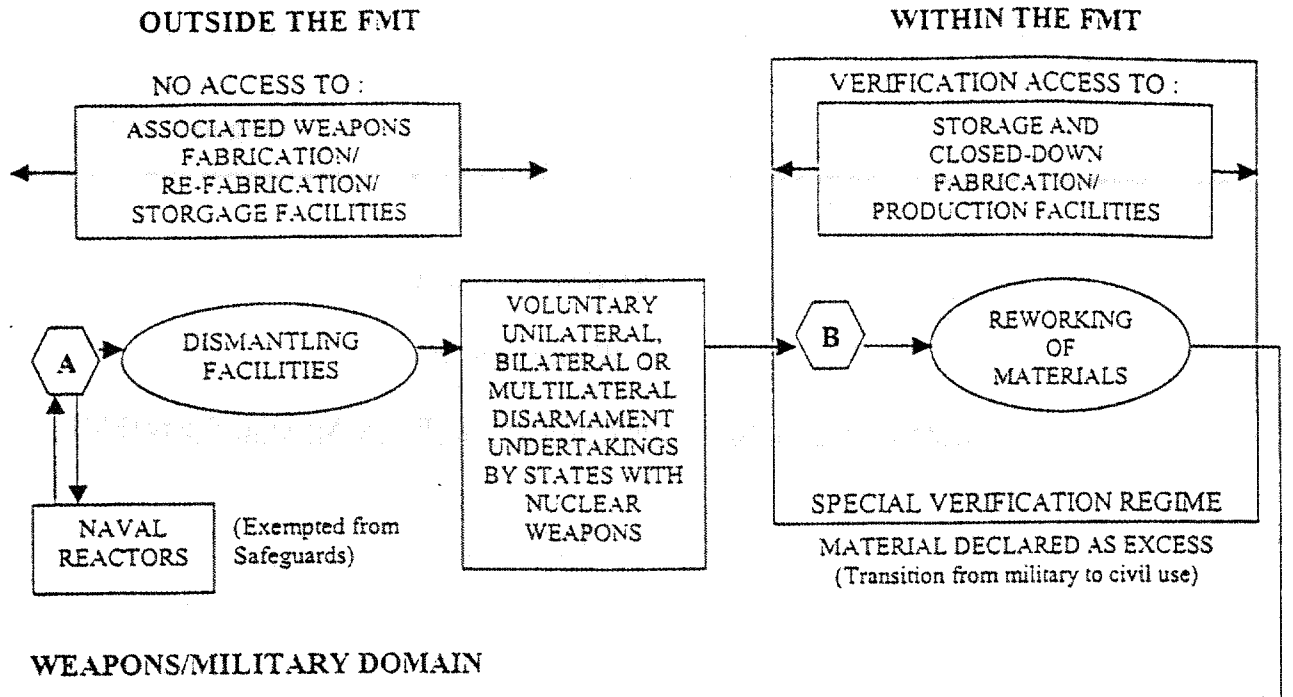

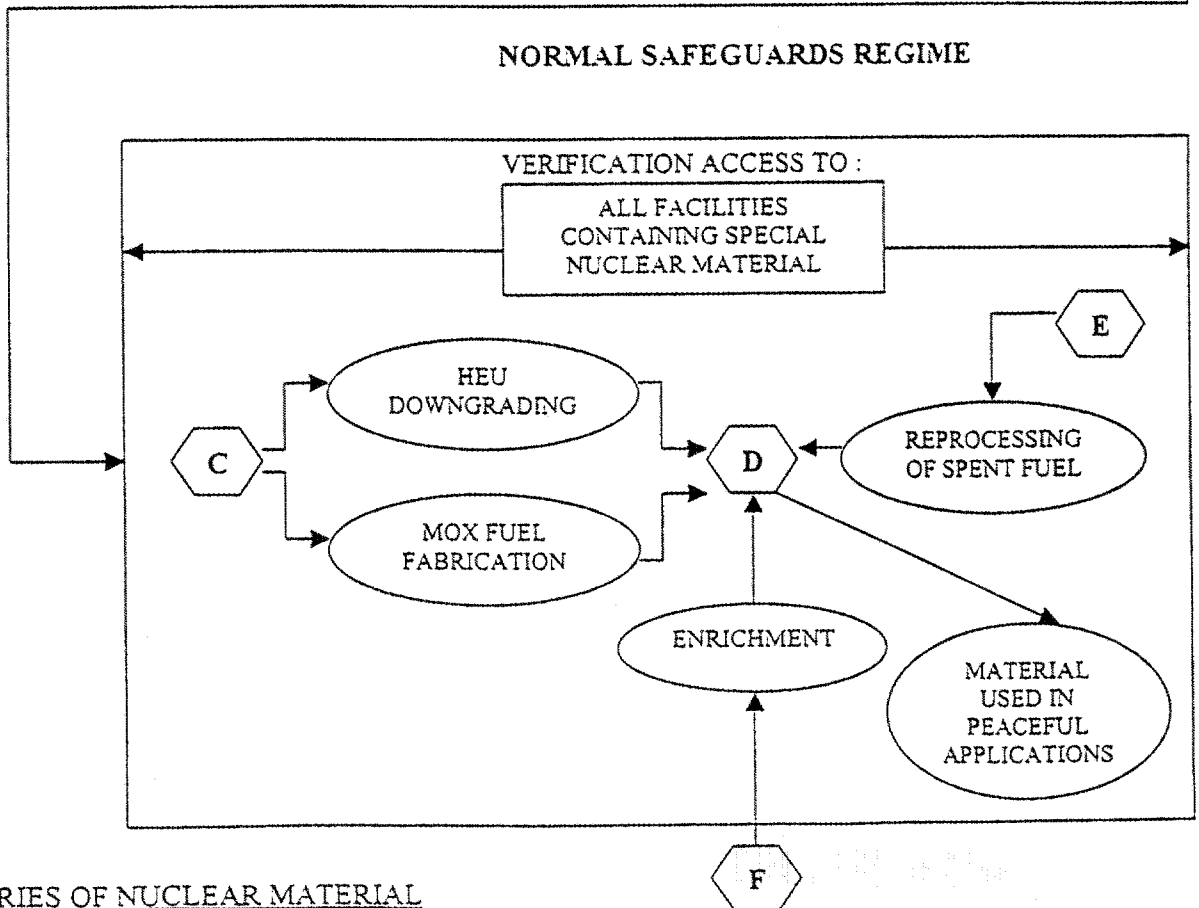

**WEAPONS/MILITARY DOMAIN**



CATEGORIES OF NUCLEAR MATERIAL

- A: Nuclear materials in weapons and associated with weapons programmes and for naval reactors
- B: Nuclear materials from dismantled nuclear weapons and intended for peaceful uses but still in sensitive form (geometrical or composition)
- C: Nuclear materials as in B but reworked into non-sensitive form
- D: New nuclear material produced (from reprocessing of spent fuel under safeguards, from enrichment of source material or obtained from material declared as excess)
- E: Nuclear material already under safeguards (spent fuel)
- F: Source material
