NOTE VERBALE DATED 8 SEPTEMBER 2006 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF PERU TO THE CONFERENCE ON DISARMAMENT ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARIAT OF THE CONFERENCE EXPRESSING THE GENERAL RESERVATION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF PERU CONCERNING THE SECTION PERTAINING TO DISARMAMENT AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY IN THE FINAL DOCUMENT OF THE MINISTERIAL MEETING OF THE COORDINATING BUREAU OF THE MOVEMENT OF NON-ALIGNED COUNTRIES, HELD IN PUTRAJAYA, MALAYSIA, FROM 27 TO 30 MAY 2006¹

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the international organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the office of the Secretary-General of the Conference on Disarmament and informs it that Peru wishes to express its general reservation concerning those chapters and paragraphs of the Final Document of the Ministerial Meeting of the Coordinating Bureau of the Movement of Non-Aligned Countries, held in Putrajaya, Malaysia, from 27 to 30 May 2006, which are not in keeping with its foreign policy, in particular as regards institutional reform in the United Nations, non-proliferation, disarmament and international security, terrorism, democracy, regional and subregional political affairs, human rights and fundamental freedoms.

In this regard, I would be grateful if this letter could be issued as an official document of the Conference on Disarmament and distributed to all the member States of the Conference and the non-member States participating in its work.
