Mexico	21-23 September 2006	Mexico participated in the Article XIV Conference , held in New York, and adopted its Final Declaration and Measures to Promote the Entry into Force of the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty	
	8 December 2005	Mexico co-sponsored resolution 60/95 entitled “Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty”, adopted by the General Assembly	
	August 2005-May 2006	Mexico regularly participated in the meetings of the Preparatory Commission for the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty Organization and its subsidiary bodies as well as in consultations aimed at promoting the Treaty’s entry into force and the completion and full operation of the verification regime	
	August 2005-May 2006	Mexico contributed to the activities of the International Monitoring System with five monitoring stations (1 hydroacoustic, 1 radionuclide and 3 seismological stations). Four of these are now certified and fully operational
