Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2048 (2012) concerning Guinea-Bissau

Note verbale dated 17 September 2012 from the Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2048 (2012) concerning Guinea-Bissau and, with reference to paragraph 10 of that resolution, in which the Council calls upon all Member States to report to the Committee within 120 days of the adoption of the resolution on the steps they have taken with a view to implementing effectively its paragraph 4, has the honour to inform the Committee about the incorporation into Brazilian law of resolution 2048 (2012).

On 15 August 2012, the President of the Republic issued decree 7.785/2012, which incorporates the text of resolution 2048 (2012) into Brazilian law and provides that all Brazilian authorities, within their respective competencies, will enforce its provisions.
