Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [2127 \(2013\)](#) concerning the Central African Republic

Note verbale dated 5 March 2014 from the Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [2127 \(2013\)](#) concerning the Central African Republic and, with reference to its note verbale on measures adopted to implement paragraphs 54 and 58 of the resolution, which establish an arms embargo, has the honour to provide the following information:

“Chile reiterates its commitment to the full implementation of Security Council resolution [2127 \(2013\)](#). The decision taken by the Council has been transmitted to all of the competent national authorities for immediate action to prevent the supply of arms or materiel to the Central African Republic.

In that context, the Central African Republic has been added to the list of countries or organizations subject to a ban or restrictions on the supply, sale or transfer of materiel for potential military use. The list is used internally by the Advisory Committee on Export of Arms and War Materiel, which was established by Supreme Decree No. 374. The function of the Committee is to advise the Ministry of Defence ahead of a potential arms sale, in accordance with paragraph 2 of Law No. 17.798 on the control of arms and similar materiel.

Accordingly, we wish to inform you that the domestic decree promulgating resolution [2127 \(2013\)](#) is currently at the administrative processing stage.”
