Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning Libya

Note verbale dated 14 May 2019 from the Permanent Mission of Oman to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Sultanate of Oman to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning Libya and has the honour to refer to the Chair's note dated 20 November 2018 regarding Council resolution 2441 (2018), in which the Council called upon Member States to present their reports to the Committee on the steps that they had taken to effectively implement the travel ban and asset freeze measures in relation to all individuals on the Committee's sanctions list.

The Permanent Mission would like to convey in this regard that the Government of the Sultanate of Oman circulated all Security Council resolutions related to the subject above, immediately after they were adopted, to the relevant authorities in the Sultanate for implementation, and they reported that there were no accounts or financial transactions recorded of persons whose names appeared on the sanctions list issued by the Security Council. In addition, none of those names had been recorded as passing through any of Oman's borders.

With reference to Aisha Qadhafi and Mohammed Muammar Qadhafi, who live in Oman, there is continuous coordination with the Committee on their exit from and entry into the territory of the Sultanate.
