The Permanent Mission of the Kingdom of Bahrain to the United Nations has the honour to refer to the note verbale dated 12 October 2022 regarding the implementation of paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution [2644 \(2022\)](#).

**Report of Bahrain on the implementation of Security Council resolution [2644 \(2022\)](#)**

Based on the commitment of Bahrain to Security Council resolutions, the government authorities within Bahrain consistently ensure that all relevant entities are notified without delay regarding any additions or amendments to the United Nations Security Council Consolidated List, including with regard to all individuals and entities subject to measures imposed by the Security Council. The law stipulates that all entities functioning within Bahraini jurisdiction are legally obliged to immediately implement all relevant measures included within these resolutions in the same manner, thereby fulfilling the obligations of Bahrain under recommendation 6 of the Financial Action Task Force concerning targeted financial sanctions related to terrorism and terrorism financing, in relation to which the overall rating of Bahrain increased for a total of seven recommendations following its enhanced follow-up report in March 2022.

In addition to the above-mentioned mechanisms and in relation to Security Council resolution [1973 \(2011\)](#), supervisory authorities conduct regular checks to ensure that the banking system is in compliance. The Central Bank of Bahrain requires all its licensees to report sanctioned accounts to it monthly.
