Report of Japan on the implementation of Security Council resolution 1970 (2011)

Measures taken by the Government of Japan against two entities and 29 individuals on the sanctions list established by the Security Council Committee concerning Libya.

Travel ban

Based on the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act, the Government of Japan has introduced measures to prevent entry into Japan or transit through the Japanese territory of the 29 individuals designated by the Security Council Committee concerning Libya.

Asset freeze

Based on the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act, the Government of Japan has introduced the following measures against:

- (a) Twenty four individuals on the sanction list:
 - (i) Restrictions on payment to those individuals;
 - (ii) Restrictions on capital transactions (deposit, trust and money loan) with those individuals;
- (b) Two entities on the sanction list: restrictions on capital transactions (deposit and trust) with those entities.
