## Letter dated 16 August 2024 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2738 \(2024\)](#), adopted on 27 June 2024, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Group of Experts on the Democratic Republic of the Congo until 1 August 2025 and requested me to take the necessary administrative measures to that effect.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [1533 \(2004\)](#) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo, I have appointed the following experts:

Ms. Mélanie De Groof, armed groups (Belgium)  
Mr. Jacques Seckène Ndour, arms (Senegal)  
Mr. Roberto Sollazzo, natural resources/finance (Italy)  
Ms. Krisztina Varga, humanitarian affairs (Romania)  
Mr. David Zounmenou, armed groups (Benin)

I have designated Ms. De Groof to serve as Coordinator of the Group of Experts. The second natural resources/finance expert will be appointed as soon as feasible.

I should be grateful if you could bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
