Expenses incurred and reimbursement received by the United Nations in connection with assistance provided to the International Criminal Court

Report of the Secretary-General

Summary

The present report is submitted pursuant to paragraph 19 of General Assembly resolution [78/6](#), in which the Assembly emphasized the need for the Secretary-General to inform the Assembly at its seventy-ninth session of the expenses incurred and reimbursements received by the United Nations in connection with assistance provided to the International Criminal Court.

1. During the period from 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024, the United Nations provided facilities and services to the International Criminal Court in the amount of \$1,240,312. These included payroll costs for staff assigned to work exclusively on matters pertaining to the Court, or for staff on inter-agency loan; interpretation services; field security; library services; broadcasting and conference support, and related services; financial disclosure programme; malicious acts insurance policy; travel and laissez-passer; and WebTV live streaming support.
2. Additional services in the amount of \$164,580 were provided to the Court by the liquidation entity of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali, the United Nations Office at Geneva, the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in the Central African Republic, the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, the United Nations Support Mission in Libya and the United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq.
3. Itemized details of the facilities and services provided to the Court by the United Nations during the period from 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024 are provided in annex I, and to the Court by various offices away from Headquarters for the same period in annex II.
4. The Court regularly reimbursed the United Nations upon receipt of invoices.
