## Letter dated 30 August 2024 from the Permanent Representative of Algeria to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

I am writing to you on behalf of the 10 elected members of the Security Council, namely Ecuador, Guyana, Japan, Malta, Mozambique, the Republic of Korea, Switzerland, Slovenia, Sierra Leone and my own country, Algeria, in reference to the distribution of the Chairs and Vice-Chairs of the subsidiary bodies of the Security Council.

The 10 elected members expect that, in making the final decision on the chairing of the Informal Working Group on Documentation and Other Procedural Questions in 2025, the Security Council will take note of the position of the current members of the Council as well as of the newly elected members. The current 10 elected members underline that they unanimously support Slovenia as Chair of the Informal Working Group in 2025.

I would highly appreciate it if you could circulate the present letter as a document of the Security Council.
