Resolution A should be corrected in the English and Spanish texts of the report to read as follows:

RESOLUTION A

STUDY OF DISCRIMINATION IN THE FIELD OF EMPLOYMENT AND OCCUPATION

The Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities,

Having examined the documentation placed at its disposal by the Secretary-General on the action taken by the International Labour Conference concerning discrimination in the field of employment and occupation,

1. Notes with great satisfaction that the Conference adopted a Convention and a Recommendation concerning discrimination in respect of employment and occupation, and states that this action marks a very important step towards the abolition of discrimination in this matter;

2. Requests the Commission on Human Rights to ask the Economic and Social Council to call upon Governments to ratify the Convention in order that it may be applied as fully and widely as possible, and to adjust their policies to the Recommendation;

3. Requests the Secretary-General to transmit to the International Labour Organisation the observations made by members of the Sub-Commission on the instruments referred to in the preceding paragraph during the debate on this agenda item;

4. Also requests the Secretary-General to keep the Sub-Commission informed regarding the implementation of the Convention and the Recommendation, requesting the relevant information if necessary from the International Labour Office.
