the Indian Ocean****Note by the Secretary-General**

1. In paragraph 1 of resolution **34/80 B** of 11 December 1979, the General Assembly **decided to** enlarge the **Ad Hoc Committee** on the **Indian Ocean** by the **addition of new** members to be appointed by the President of the **Assembly** on the recommendation of the **Committee**.
2. BY a communication dated 6 May 1987, the **President** of the General Assembly informed the Secretary-General that, on the **basis** of the recommendation made by the **Ad Hoc** Committee at **its** 312th meeting, on 2 April 1967, and in accordance with the established practice, he had appointed Zimbabwe **as** an additional member of the Committee.
3. **As** a result of the above appointment, the **Ad Hoc** Committee on the Indian Ocean is **composed** of the following 49 Member **States**:
