LETTER FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT  
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL FORWARDING A RESOLUTION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY  
CONCERNING A COMMITTEE ON RULES GOVERNING ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

25 November 1946
