

DRAFT RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL CONTROL OF ATOMIC ENERGY  
SUBMITTED BY THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED STATES AT THE THREE HUNDRED  
AND EIGHTEENTH MEETING OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL, 11 JUNE 1948

THE SECURITY COUNCIL,

Having received and examined the First, the Second, and the Third Reports  
of the United Nations Atomic Energy Commission,

ACCEPTS these Reports and,

APPROVES the General Findings (Part II C) and Recommendations (Part III)  
of the First Report, and the Specific Proposals of Part II of the Second  
Report as constituting the necessary basis for establishing an effective  
system of international control of atomic energy in accordance with the  
terms of reference of the United Nations Atomic Energy Commission and,

APPROVES the "Report and Recommendations of the Atomic Energy Commission"  
(Part I) of the Third Report of the United Nations Atomic Energy Commission, and

DIRECTS the Secretary-General to transmit to the General Assembly and  
to the member nations of the United Nations, the First, Second and Third  
Reports of the United Nations Atomic Energy Commission, together with the  
record of the Security Council's approval thereof.
