NOTE

The resolutions of the Security Council, numbered in accordance with a system adopted in 1964, are published in yearly volumes of *Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council*. The new system, which has been applied retroactively to resolutions adopted before 1 January 1965, became fully operative on that date.

The meeting was called to order at 5.25 p.m.

Expression of thanks to the retiring President

1. The PRESIDENT: I should like to pay a tribute, on behalf of the Council, to Mr. Carlos Ozores Typaldos, representative of Panama and President of the Council for the month of November, for the great diplomatic skill with which he guided the Council's work last month. I am sure I speak for all of us in expressing deep appreciation to him.

Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted.

2. The PRESIDENT: This meeting of the Council has been convened in accordance with the request made to the President of the Council by the representative of Uganda on behalf of the Group of African States and the non-aligned members of the Council.

3. Members of the Council have before them document S/15511, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by Guyana, Jordan, Panama, Togo, Uganda and Zaire.

4. It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on that draft resolution. If I hear no objection, I shall put it to the vote now.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

The draft resolution was adopted unanimously (resolution 525 (1982)).

5. The PRESIDENT: The Council has thus concluded the present stage of its consideration of the item on its agenda.
