Countering the use of information and communications technologies for criminal purposes

Russian Federation: draft decision*

Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes

The General Assembly, recalling its resolution [74/247](#) of 27 December 2019 and its resolution [75/282](#) of 26 May 2021, in which it decided that the Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes shall convene at least six sessions, of 10 days each, to commence in January 2022, and conclude its work in order to provide a draft convention to the Assembly at its seventy-eighth session, and that the Ad Hoc Committee shall hold the first, third and sixth negotiating sessions in New York and the second, fourth and fifth sessions in Vienna, decides that the Ad Hoc Committee shall hold its first negotiating session in New York from 24 January to 4 February 2022.

* In order for the General Assembly to take action on the present proposal, it will be necessary to decide to consider agenda item 109 directly in plenary meeting.
