#### **Letter dated 3 December 2010 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2010/616)**

**The President:** Members of the Council have before them document S/2010/645, containing the text of a draft resolution submitted by France, Japan, Nigeria, Turkey, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

Members also have before them document S/2010/616, containing a letter dated 3 December 2010 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism addressed to the President of the Security Council.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution. Unless I hear any objection, I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.
